Helpful tips:

Author's Name – Follow the recommendations for citing the names of authors of books. Take the name directly from the document, reverse the name for alphabetizing and put a period after it. If no author's name is given, start with the title of the document. Quijano, Elaine.

Name of publishing service or the name of the sponsoring institution or organization, which usually appears at the bottom of the site's home page.

Example:
